WEARABILITY

- Foot holes are coming back quick, within 2-3 weeks. Cricket wickets are being able to be made constantly on the deck for a period of 3-4 months season.
- Between 4-5 games are being played on the wicket for the season, compared with the other wickets on average 1-2 games with full recovery.
- In total there is a 21-day turnaround with the wickets – use: recovery: use again.

KEY FEATURES

LOW MAINTENANCE (COMPARISON TO WINTERGREEN):

- Less maintenance in-regards-to grooming and verti-cutting for prepping is required when compared with Wintergreen.
- The thin leaf makes it easier to prep wickets compared to Wintergreen. The cricket wicket with IronCutter[®] is scarified and groomed once for the whole season compared with the Wintergreen wickets. They must be done 7-9 times in the season.

MOWING:

- A fully recovered wicket is being mowed at a height of 8-10mm and keeps its colour.
- For game day wickets, it is mowed at 4mm. Again, it keeps its colour and bounces back afterwards.
- A mowing height is back to 8-9mm after one week of recovery.

MATCH DAY PERFORMANCE:

Batters and bowlers love it, and their feedback has been extremely positive. Because it keeps its green colour, players were initially a little weary of it, but it plays true. It kisses off the surface lovely due to the low thatch. There is a little bit of turn for the spinners. A cricket wicket using IronCutter[®] Elite Hybrid Bermudagrass is an all-round awesome wicket!”
